

Project Management Pronto - (5 Days)

Overview

This course introduces the Project Manager to skills in managing a Project using generally accepted best practices as described by Project Management Body of Knowledge (*PMBOK® Guide*) of Project Management Institute (PMI). The Course also prepares the Project Management Professional (PMP)® Certification aspirant for the PMP® Exam. It provides the *thirty-five* contact hours/PDUs needed for submission of application. The course is designed with adult learning technique. It takes the individual through the entire *PMBOK® Guide – 5th Edition*. The concepts mentioned in the guide are explained and backed up with relevant examples. All the *ten* knowledge areas, *five* process groups (which have *forty-seven* processes) are taken through in a logical sequence with applications. Each module has a set of questions to challenge understanding. Some extra questions are provided for practice. At the end of the five days is a pen / paper simulated PMP exam.

Course Pre-requisites

The course is applicable to practitioners of Project Management including Project Manager, Engineer, Lead, Executive, Business Analyst, member of PMO team and others. The PMP® Application needs an individual to have at least 4500 hours of project experience. By the time an individual obtains such experience he would have above 3 years of industry experience and a few training on various traits of management and leadership.
